Competitor Requirements:

Each athlete is required to present the following documents during registration:

- Firearms licenses and gun registration certificates will be checked by the range manager. Anyone without these documents cannot participate.
- Athletes younger than 18 but older than 10, or those without a firearms license, may only use a firearm in the presence of a person older than 21 who holds a firearms license of groups B or C for at least 3 years and ensures the safe handling of the firearm and ammunition.

If fewer than 6 shooters participate in a category, no final will be held; results will be determined from the qualification round.

Scoring:

Trap and Skeet will be conducted according to the current ISSF Shotgun Rules (Olympic Games format).

Awards:

Competitors in 1st–3rd place in each category will receive a trophy and material prizes.

Entry Fee:

Training round (regardless of discipline and category - purchased card from the range manager)

Competition – All categories

125 targets

1750 CZK / 70 Eur

Entry fees and training rounds are payable upon registration no later than 15:00 on September 26 th, 2025. Payment in cash on site.

Protests:

A written protest must, in accordance with ISSF rules, be submitted to the jury within 10 minutes after the end of the round in which the event occurred, with a fee of 500 CZK or 20 Eur.

Accommodation:

Accommodation is the responsibility of each participant.

Parking:

Parking is provided at the shooting range in designated areas (not on grass).

Caravans: CZK 500 for the entire competition (collected regardless of stay duration).

Alternative: Free public parking outside the range.

Catering:

Food and refreshments will be provided at the range.

Weapons & Ammunition:

Competitors use their own firearms and ammunition.

Shot load must not exceed 24.0 g (tolerance +0.5 g, max. 24.5 g). Maximum pellet size: 2.6 mm.

Draw:

The draw for starting numbers will be conducted by the chief referees of each category before the technical meeting on Friday, September 26, 2025, at 18:00.
